The Plaintiff, Isenberg Bros., states that the defendant is indebted to them in the sum of \$27.00 for clothing purchased of this plaintiff by the said defendant for which he promised to pay the amount as above stated. That defendant at the time of making said purchase in order to pay for said clothing executed and delivered to thisb plaintiff his check for \$27.00 drawn on the Mercer National Bank of Harrodsburg, Kentucky and dated December 26th., 1920; that said check was duly presented by this plaintiff at the Mercer National Bank for payment but that same was not paid and was returned to this defendant. Said check is filed herewith as part hereof.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for judgment etc.
