Wherefore, Plaintiff prays for judgment against the defendant

for the sum of \$27.00 ; for costs of this suit and for a general order of attachment of defendant's property or so much thereof

as will satisfy and pay said debt, interest and costs, and that the garnishee, Mercer National Bank of Harrodsburg, Kentucky be compelled to come in and make report what funds it has, if any

it has in its hands belonging to this defendant and to hold same subject to the orders of this court.
