

# BAIL BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant, A. W. Gehouse being in custody  
of the Sheriff of Mercer County, charged with the offense  
of Stealing a dog without bane and  
being admitted to bail in the sum of One Hundred Dollars:

THEREFORE, we A. W. Gehouse Principal  
and A. W. Gehouse Surety, of Mercer County, Kentucky,  
do hereby undertake that the above named A. W. Gehouse  
shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 18  
day of March 20, to answer said charge, and shall at all times  
render himself amendable to the order and process of said Court in the  
prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execu-  
tion thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that  
we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of 100.00  
Dollars.
