The plaintiff, Thomas Tewmey, states that on the 25th day of ~~November~~, 1920, the defendant, Oliver Mc. Ginnis, executed and delivered to him for value received his certain promissory note for the sum of \$150.00 with 8% interest thereon from date until paid and that said note was due and payable in 12 months from date. He says that no part of said note has ever been paid although payment has been repeatedly demanded. He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract and that it is just and due and that he ought to collect said amount and interest thereon as aforesaid. The reason the note is not filed ~~herewith~~ is because it is lost. He says that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's claim and the claims of the defendant's creditors and that the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$150.00 with interest thereon from the 25th day of October, 1920 until paid, for all costs expended in this action and for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled including a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant.
