The Plaintiffs M.C. Helm and M.T.Helm, state that they are now and were at the times hereinafter stated, partners, engaged in merchandising, under the firm name and style of M.C. Helm & Son located and doing business in the city of Danville, Ky.

Plaintiffs say that the defts, W.M. Gibson and Mrs WM. Gibson, are husband and wife, residing and engaged in Farming in Mercer County, Ky/

That the defendant Citizen's Bank of Burgin, is a coporate created and organized under the banking laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and under its charter are now and were at the times hereinafter mentioned, doing a General Banking business in the Town of Burgin, Ky.

Plaintiffs say that on the first day of Jan . 1922, the defendants, executed and delivered to the firm of Helm & Barker who were then partners engaged in Merchandising in the city of Danville, ther certain promissory note, whereby they undertook and promised to pay to the said firm the sum of Ninety Nine and 04/100 dollars together with 6% interest thereon from date until paid, which said note was duly assigned and transferred to the plaintiffs, and is filed herewith as part hereof no part of which has ever been paid, although same has long since been due,

Plaintiffs say that the claim in this action is for money due upon the note aforesaid, and is a just claim and plaintiff's ought as they believe to recover thereon the sum of \$99.04 with 6% interest thereon from the 1st day of Jan.1922 until paid,

Plaintiffs further aver that defenents have no property in this state or not enough thereof to satisfy plaitiffs demand and that the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in
