Comes the Garnishee and states that on February 25, 1922, defendant W. M. Gibson, delivered to it 1628 pounds of tobacco.

On February 25, 1922, Garnishee made an advance payment to said defendant in the sum of \$74.10

On March 10, 1922, said W. M. Gibson assigned to Anderson & Spillman his interest in the balance of the proceeds from said tobacco to the extent of \$90.90

On May 15, 1922, Garnishee paid said Anderson & Spillman on account of sales of said tobacco the sum of \$79.10.

That there will be a payment made on final sales of all tobacco, but the exact amount thereof or the time when such payment will be made is not now known to the Garnishee.

WHEREFORE, Garnishee prays to be protected in its rights, for its costs and for all proper relief.
