

## **BAIL BOND.**

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant Charlie Snick being in custody  
of the Sheriff of Mercer County, charged with the offense  
of Assault & Battery and  
being admitted to bail in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars:

THEREFORE, we Chokai Smith Principal  
and Harley Smith Surety, of Mercer County, Kentucky,  
do hereby undertake that the above named Harley Smith  
shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 5<sup>th</sup>

day of June 1920, to answer said charge, and shall at all times render himself amendable to the order and process of said Court in the prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execution thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of 500.00 Dollars.
