Par- 1- Defendant for answer to plaintiff's petition herein denies that the plowing of 20 acres of land was reasonably worth \$60.00, or any amount greater than \$50.00; denies that he disced said land once and half over again, or done any discing more than 1 1/2 days, which was worth not more than \$7.00 per day or a total of \$10.50; denies that he plowed only 7 1/2 days, but alleges that he plowed 10 days at \$6.00 per day, leaving a balance due plaintiff of not exceeding \$26.50.

Par- 2-

Defendant admits that he owes plaintiff \$2.50 for setting up fodder and \$10.00 for shucking and hauling in corn, making a total of \$12.50- Defendant denies that instead of taking one-half of said corn that he took 12 barrels more than one-half, and denies that he took any quantity greater than one-half of said corn- Denies he owes \$60.00 for corn- Wherefore defendant offers to confess judgment and does confess that judgment should be rendered against him for the sum of \$19.50.

He asks that all claims and parts of claims in excess of said \$19.50 be dismissed at plaintiff's costs from this confession of judgment-
