This case coming on to be heard and defendant being present in person and informed of the nature of the warrant which is for disturbing religious worship, thereupon both the plaintiff and defendant announce ready for trial and after hearing the evidence the Court decided that the defendant is guilty as charged and fixes his punishment at a fine of \$50.00 and imprisonment in the work-house for 20 days at hard labor.

It is further adjudged that the Commonwealth recover of Nath Camie the sum of \$50.00 and cost of this action, which sum if not paid or replevined shall be worked out at hard labor ^{in the} at work-house in Mercer County Kentucky at rate of \$1.00 per day until judgment is fully satisfied.

It is further adjudged that defendant be confined in the work-house for a period of 20 days.
