

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff or any Constable of Mercer County:

Whereas Robert Dean hath made complaint to me as Judge of the Mercer County Court, that S. T. Elliott

did on the 2nd, day of June 1915, forcibly

enter the property of said Dean on the Warwick Pike about

one and one half miles North of Harrodsburg, Ky, and take possession of a portion of said land, by moving a fence and setting up a post

on the land of said Dean, and taking possession thereof

which was in the peaceable possession of said Dean

You are therefore commanded to summon the said Elliott

to appear at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky., to answer on the day of June 1915, the charge

of forcible aforesaid, and give to the said

at least three days' notice of the time and place of the trial, and have then and there this writ.
