

To the Sheriff of Mercer County:-  
Exceeding by getting into the house of his wife  
Whereas J. H. Farley and J. S. Ison have c  
complained to me that Roy Goodpaster did on the day of December 1917  
and at divers and sundry other times during the year 1917, forcibly detain  
from said J. H. Farley one house and outbuildings and tract of land of about  
 $3\frac{1}{2}$  acres in Mercer County in the junction of the Handy turnpike and the  
Sorrell Lane, known as the Bradshaw place, which was in the possession of  
said Goodpaster as tenant and which the said tenant now forcibly holds a-  
gainst said Farley; you are therefore commanded to summon the said Goodpaster  
to appear before me at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky on the 5th day  
of January 1918 at which time inquiry will be made and a trial had as to sai  
d forcibly detainer, and you will give the said Goodpaster at least three  
days notice of the time and place of trial and have then and there this writ
