his property, and that the defendant is about to remove, or has removed

the same from the State, out of this State, not leaving

any means for the plaintiff to recover the same, or the claims of

the plaintiff. He says that the defendant has sold,

and otherwise disposed of, his property, or suffered or permitted

it to be sold, with the fraudulent intent to cheat, hinder and

delay his creditors.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a general order of

attachment against the property of the said defendant and for all other

relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled and as prayed for in

the original petition.
