ANSWER OF GARNISHEE BURLEY TOBACCO GROWERS' COOPERATIVE

JOHN BOTTOM

DEFENDANT

Comes Garnishee and states that on January 17th, 1924, John Bottoms, who is a tenant on the farm of David C. Terhune, Harrodsburg, Ky., delivered to it 55 pounds of tobacco of the 1923 crop, for which was issued participation certificate #135189, in the name of David Terhune.

That on March 5th, 1924 said John Bottoms delivered to it 2685 pounds of tobacco of the 1923 crop, for which was issued participation certificate #137013, in the name of D. R. Terhune.

On the above dates Garnishee paid the advance on said tobacco as follows:

David Terhune	P.C. #135149	\$ 4.05
D. R. Terhune	#137013	186.25

There will be further distribution payments on the 1923 crop of tobacco delivered to Garnishee by its grower members, but the date of such payments, or the amount thereof, is unknown to Garnishee at the present time.

Garnishee is not informed that the John Bottoms, whose account is herein listed, and the John Bottoms, defendant herein, are one and the same person, but if such is not the case, it prays to be allowed to amend its answer accordingly.

Garnishee is not informed as to what interest, if any, that John Bottoms, defendant herein, has in the tobacco covered by the above numbered certificates.

WHEREFORE, Garnishee prays to be protected in its rights, for its costs herein expended and for all proper relief.
