Plaintiffs, Adams & Langford, a ~~corpor~~ ^{partnership} ~~ation~~, doing business in the State of Kentucky and with its principal place of business in Harrodsburg, Mercer County, Kentucky, state that defendant, H. S. Yates is indebted to it in the sum of \$40.40, on note with interest included; that said note is just, due and unpaid, and though demand has been made upon defendant, he has failed and refused and still fails and refuses to pay said note, or any part of same. Wherefore etc.

Plaintiffs state that this is an action upon a contract, being a contract to pay money on note; that said note is just; that it believes it ought to recover the amount of the note, and interest, to wit, \$40.40; that defendant has no property in this state subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy the demand of these plaintiffs, and that the collection of the note and interest will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and return of no property found.
