

COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY

to the Sheriff of Mercer County;

Whereas S.W.Royalty has made complaint to me, D.Lee Currey, Judge of the Mercer County Court, that Sam J.Sims, did on of about the \_\_\_\_\_ day of January 1914, forcibly enter into a small tract of land in Mercer County, Ky, at the North/east corner of the lands of Sam J.Sims, and the lands of S.W.Royalty, said tract being 12 feet wide at one end and running 34 feet to a point, which land was in the peaceable possession of the said S.W.Royalty, and which land said Sims now holds against him:

You are therefore commanded to notify the Defendant to appear before me at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky on the 9th ~~th~~ day of March 1914, at 10 A.M. at which time there will be a trial of said forcible entry ; and you will give the Defendant at least three days notice hereof.
