The plaintiff, First National Bank of Harrodsburg, Ky, states that on Mch 4th 1925 the defendant, Robert Kinniard, by his promissory note which he executed and delivered to the plaintiff, agreed and promised sixty days thereafter to pay to the plaintiff \$75.00 with interest thereon from date, no part of which has ever been paid. A copy of said note is filed herewith.

It says that the defendant has not sufficient property in this State subject to execution to satisfy the plaintiff's demand and that its demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found: that the claim is just and that it ought to recover the said sum of \$75.00 with interest from Mch 4th 1925 and the cost of this action.

Wherefore it prays judgment against the defendant for the said sum and interest and its cost, and for a general order of attachment and garnishee against the defendant. It prays for all general and equitable relief.
