-vs- Affidavit and Claim for Exemptions.

Deft

Affiant, defendant, E.G.Lake, states that he is a resident of a  
of Mercer County, Ky, with a family residing with him, consisting of a wife  
and three infant children, two boys and one girl, whose ages range from  
1 yr to 10, all of whom are dependent on him <sup>for</sup> support. He states that  
he owns no property, money, choses in action, or personal property of any  
character or description except as herein stated;

one ax, one hoe, 2 beds, bedding and furniture sufficient only for family  
use, one carpet, one table, books not exceeding \$3.00 in value, 6 chairs,  
wearing apparel sufficient only for family, provisions including bread-  
stuff and animal food sufficient for last two or three days.

He states that he has no wages coming to him except the amount  
due him from the Southern Ry Co attached in this action. That he has  
no crop growing or otherwise, no provender for live stock; one sew-  
ing machine worth \$10.; one cooking stove, appendages and cooking uten-  
sils not exceeding \$20.

He states that under the law he is entitled to all of the property  
mentioned above, and hereby claims same as exempt to him as against the  
attachment issued in this case, and he prays the Court to so adjudge, and to  
discharge said attachment.
