E.G Lake, &c

Deft

The Deft having been duly summoned herein and failing to answer as to his indebtedness to Plff, it is adjudged by the Court that Plffs recover of Deft E.G. Lake the sum of \$27.50, with interest thereon at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from May 10th 1915 until paid, and his costs herein expended.

The grounds of attachment are sustained, but in view of Deft Lake's claim for exemptions filed, it is adjudged that only ten per cent of the fund attached in the hands of the Southern Railway Company is subject to the attachment, and it appearing from the answer of said Company that said fund is \$29.54, it is ordered that \$2.95 thereof be applied to Plff's judgment.

Deft Southern Railway Co in Ky, garnishee herein, having filed a statement showing indebtedness to the Deft E G Lake in the sum of \$29.54, it is now ordered that the Deft pay over said sum to J.F Vanarsdall Atty for E.G. Lake, and the attachment and garnishment herein against the Deft Southern Ry Co is hereby released and said Deft discharged. Thereupon the Southern Ry Co paid said fund to the said Atty who paid into Court \$2.95, the sum adjudged subject to the attachment.
