The Plaintiff, Mercer Garage & Welding, a partnership, composed of Currey Marksbury, W.T. Durr and Mrs. Andrew Comingo, states that the defendant is indebted to them in the sum of \$41.29 on account; that said account is filed herewith as part hereof; that same is past due and unpaid and there are no offsets or discounts against the same.
