Plaintiff, Mercer Garage & Welding Company, states that the defendant, Ray (Raymond) Davenport is indebted to them in the sum of \$15.04 on account, itemized statement of which is filed herewith as part hereof.

They state that said account is just; that they believe they ought to recover the full amount of the account, to wit, \$15.04; that this is an action upon a contract being a contract to pay money on account for services rendered; that defendant has no property in this state subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy and pay said indebtedness and the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and return of no property found.
