Plaintiff, Mercer Garage & Welding Company, states that the defendant, Franklin Ransdell is indbted to them in the sum of \$62.46 on account, itemized statement of which is filed herewith as part hereof.

They state that said account is past due and unpaid; that defendant has no property in this state subject to execution or not enought thereof to satisfy and pay said indebtedness; that they believe they ought to recover the full amount of the account, to wit, 62.46; that said account is just; and that the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found.
