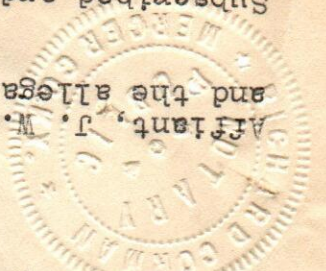
Interest from March 4, 1920 less \$8.50 and for a general order of attachment and for all proper relief and costs.
