

Application of William & Gracie for relief from erroneous assessment.

JUDGMENT:

It appears to the Court that the Sheriff, County Attorney and Tax Commissioner of Horse County Kentucky have been notified of this appeal as appears from their endorsement thereon, and it further appearing to the Court that the firm of William and Gracie, composed of James P. Williams and C. B. Gracie have been assessed for payment of taxes for the year 1923 with a water meter at a valuation of \$ 250.00 and that they have paid taxes on said meter and it further appearing to the Court that Mrs. George E. Edwards, who furnished said meter to said firm, has also been assessed for taxes for the year 1923 on said meter and that she has also paid taxes on same, it is therefore ordered and adjudged that the assessment against William & Gracie on said meter be and the same is hereby declared erroneous, and the Sheriff of Horse County Kentucky is hereby ordered and directed to refund to William & Gracie the taxes paid by them on said meter for the year 1923; and it is ordered that this action be certified to the Sheriff of Horse County Kentucky and to the Auditor of Public Accounts at Frankfort Kentucky so in such cases by law made and provided.
