


The plaintiff, A. B. Teater, states that the defendant, Sid Hendren, is indebted to him in the sum of \$ 70.65 for goods and merchandise sold, furnished and delivered to this defendant at his special instance and request, the defendant agreeing when he bought said goods to pay for them. Plaintiff says that altho often requested the defendant has failed and refused to pay for said goods and merchandise and that the same is now due and owing and wholly unpaid.

Plaintiff says that his claim is just, due and owing; and that he ought to recover the said sum \$ 70.65 with interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from ~~July 10th 1924~~ <sup>Jan 1st 1924</sup> and the costs of this action: that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution ~~xxxxxx~~ or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand, and that the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found.


