Yandell Terhune had been missing in action since May 7, 1942. Terhune went to the Philippines as one of Mercer county's 66 men of Company D, formerly the Harrodsburg Tank Unit.</p> <p>Before the Pearl Harbor raid on Dec. 7, Mrs. Terhune mailed a fruit cake to her son in the Philippines, hoping it would reach him for Christmas. The cake was returned, marked "undeliverable."
