The plaintiff states that the property claimed by him in this action is as follows: One folding bed, oak, of the value of \$25.00; two quilts white checked of the value \$5.00 each; one pillar, goose feather, of the value of \$2.50; two over coats, one a rain coat, of the value of \$2.00, and the other a heavy brown over coat of the value of \$5.00; 3 suits underwear of the value of \$5.00; 5 shirts, 2 O.D.'s, and the rest blue shirts; one pair leather leggins, value \$3.00; pair work shoes of the value of \$2.00; 2 pair rifing breeches, worth \$2.50 per pair; Government papers, discharges, etc-

Plaintiff says that these goods are in the possession wrongfully of the defendant and that he is the owner of them and entitled to the immediate possession thereof; that they were not taken for a tax or a fine against this plaintiff nor seized under an execution, attachment or distress warrant, nor under an order or judgment of a court against him. He says that his cause of action has accrued within a year last past.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant for a delivery of these articles to him or if said articles can not be delivered for their value amounting to \$60.00 and for all the costs of this action and for all relief to which he is entitled-- special, general and proper-
