The plaintiff, ~~Bohon-Lucas-~~ W.A.Taylor, states that within the last few months he has sold and delivered to the defendant, Bohon Lucas, at his special instance and request goods and merchandise to the value of \$93.64. He says that said account is due and unpaid and that it is just and he ought to recover thereon the said amount of \$93.64 and costs of this action. He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract and that defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and the demands of the defendant's creditors and the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$93.64 and all costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against ~~the~~ property and for a summon against the Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association as garnishee.
