The Plaintiff states that the defendants are corporations under the Kentucky law; that on Octo 16, 1923 he delivered to the defendants, the Stock Yard Co being the agent of the Railroad Co, 21 cattle at the Yard in Louisville, Ky and the defendants then and there undertook to transport and deliver them to this plaintiff at Convoy Ky; that a bill of lading was issued by the Railroad Co showing said shipment same being issued in its name by the Yard Co; said bill is now in the possession of defendant Railroad Co and cannot be filed herewith.

He states that although he delivered the defendants 21 cattle that they re-delivered to him only 20 cattle, to his loss in the sum of \$36.00 no part of which has been paid and for which sum he prays judgment and for all proper relief.
