You are hereby commanded forthwith to search the house and premises adjacent thereto now in the possession of John W. Johnson and Clyde Rickles ; said premises being described as follows, to-wit:

Near the village of Shakertown in Mercer County Kentucky and on the farm of A. Gillispie the said farm being located on the South side of the Burgin and Shaker-town pike and in said County and state and is the property that adjoins Tucker on the East and Vanarsdale on the South and the Pennebaker Home for girls property on the West and the Shakertown and Burgin Pike on the North.

If you find one game red rooster, three plymouth rock hens, two yellow hens and one black hen in said house or on said premises adjacent thereto you will immediately take possession thereof together with the body of John W. Johnson or such other persons that may appear to be in possession thereof and deliver them to me at my office as speedily as possible.
