TO ANY SHERIFF, CONSTABLE OR POLICE OFFICER OF THE STATE OF KENTUCKY

You are hereby commanded forthwith to search the house and premises adjacent thereto now in the possession of Iva Duncan and said premises being described as follows, to-wit: In Harrodsburg, Mercer County Kentucky the said property being a frame building or house on the East side of Greenville Street and being the second house North from the entrance of Springhill Cemetery in said town and County.

If you find three game chickens, one rooster, two hens, the hens being marked by the skin pulled back on their neck and rooster marked by a hole in the web of the right foot, in said house or on said premises adjacent thereto you will immediately take possession thereof together with the body of Elmer Duncan or such other person or persons that may appear to be in possession thereof and deliver them to me at my office as speedily as possible.
