He states that same is long past due and that no part of same has been paid . wherefore plf.prays for a judgement against the def.in the sum of \$52.65 with interest at 6%untill paid and for his costs and all proper relief.

3rd. Reaffirming the allegations in the in the first&second paragraphs And for further cause of action against the def. the plf. ~~not~~ states the def is indebted to it in the sum of \$4.00 for mchd .furnished to said def . from Jan.~~1/27~~th to May 11 1915. He states that/~~not~~ said account is long past due and that no part of same has been paid

Wherefore the plf prays for a judgment against the def in the sum \$4.00 with interest from ~~date~~ July 1st untill paid and for his costs and all proper relief.
