County in which this writ is served, before the County Judge
of said county on the 26 day of March at ^{10:15 AM A.M.} ~~11:00 AM~~ and that
you then and there state in writing the cause of detaining
the said Robert Burns and produce your authority for so
doing; and hereof you are not to fail, under the penalties
denounced by law against those who disobey this writ, and
to submit to and receive all those things which shall
then and there be adjudged in this behalf.
