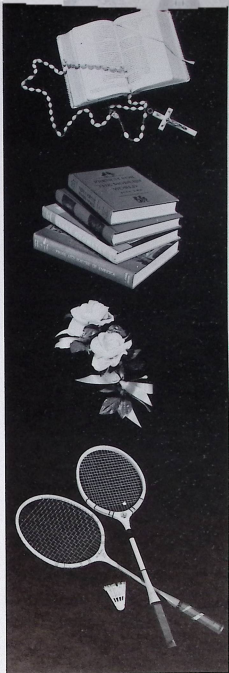

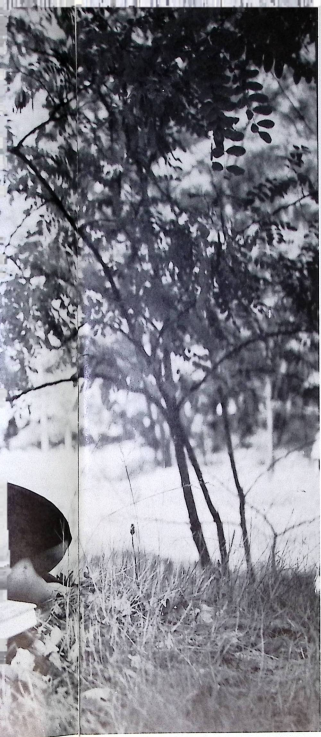

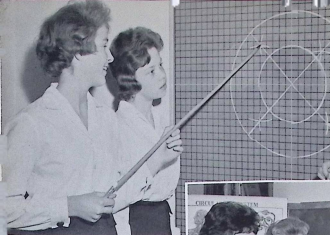

Sophomores branch into new fields



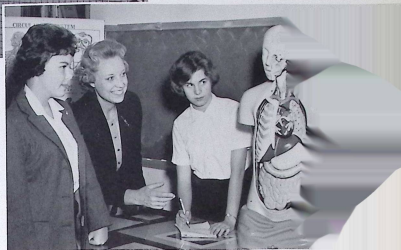

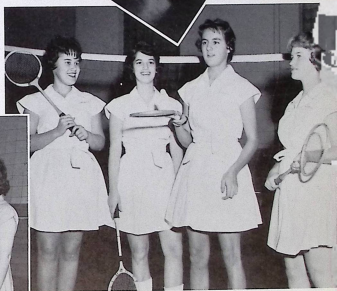
