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COLLECTION DETAILS

Biography/Historical Note: Beth Dingman is a feminist activist, printer, and co-founder of New Victoria Publishers, a women-run printing and publishing collective established in 1975. Her involvement in feminist labor organizing directly led to the creation of the press. After being dismissed from a printing company when she and other women employees requested fair compensation, Dingman helped form an alternative, women-operated printing space modeled on collective labor and socially engaged publishing.

Dingman located and prepared the site that would become New Victoria's first working facility, an unheated barn in Lebanon, New Hampshire, and participated in renovating it for press operations. The press initially printed materials for activist organizations in the Upper Valley, serving as both a workplace and a community hub during a period of intense political activity, including antiwar activism, feminist organizing, and alternative media production.

Operating as New Victoria Printers, the collective emphasized consensus-based administration, minimal wages, and communal living practices. Dingman supported ongoing press work even as financial precarity meant that she and her household shared space with multiple community members to sustain mortgage and operations costs. Though collective governance occasionally led to conflict, including a later civil wage dispute that was dismissed, the organization maintained a cooperative orientation. It produced affordable print materials for local activist movements.

In 1985, Dingman transitioned with collaborator Claudia McKay from printing services to full-scale publishing as New Victoria Publishers, shifting toward fiction and nonfiction works authored by Lesbian writers. This development marked a period of greater editorial autonomy and mission-driven output. Dingman oversaw the publishing enterprise primarily from her home in Vermont until her retirement and the eventual transfer of the press to new ownership. Through New Victoria's operation from 1975 to 2007, Dingman contributed meaningfully to feminist print culture, the development of independent women-owned publishing in the

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United States, and the preservation and dissemination of Lesbian creative and political expression.
