Do you still have your regular bridge sessions and/o watching the telly ?

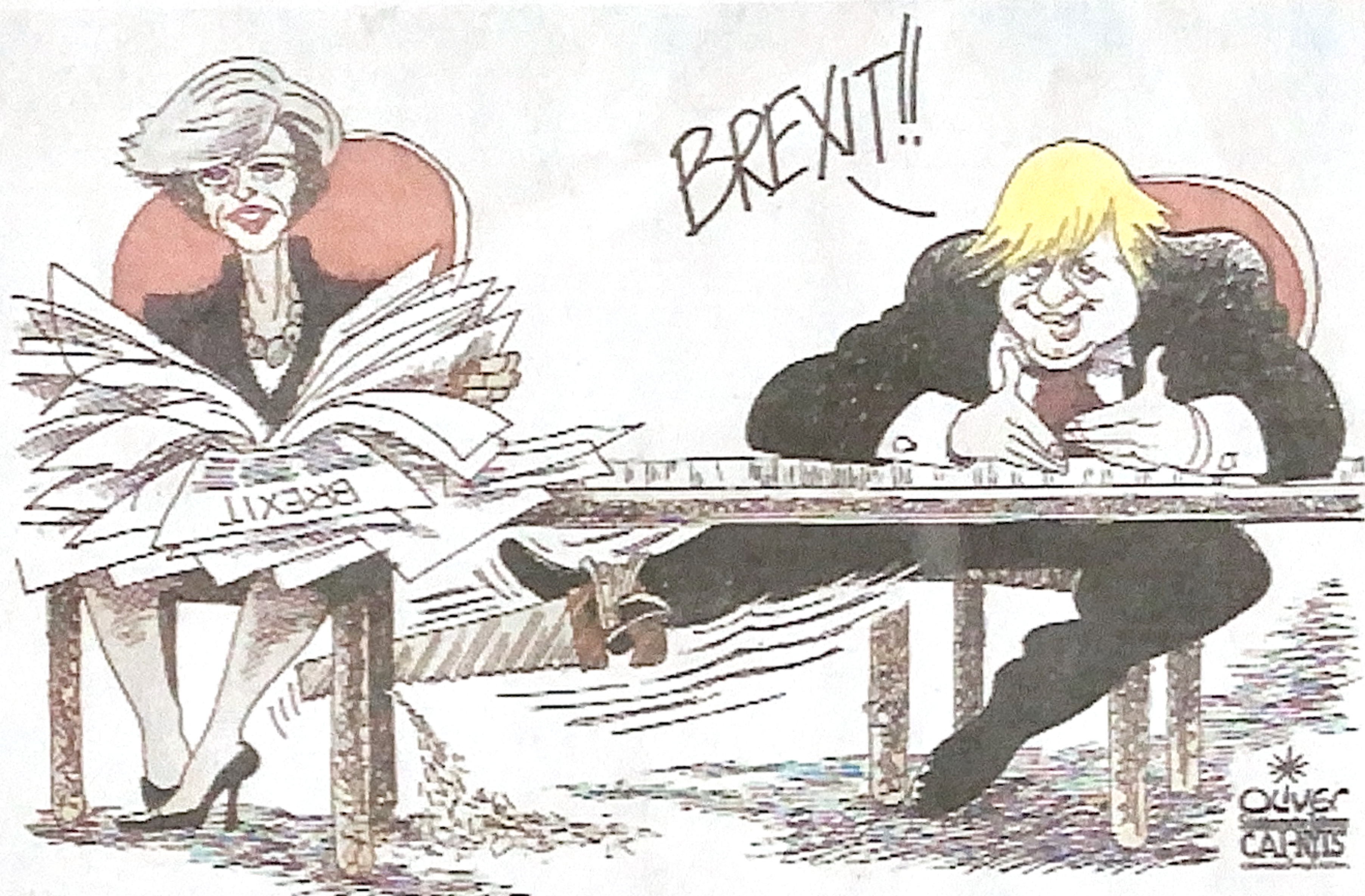
Questions, questions implying that we are interested in your well being.
