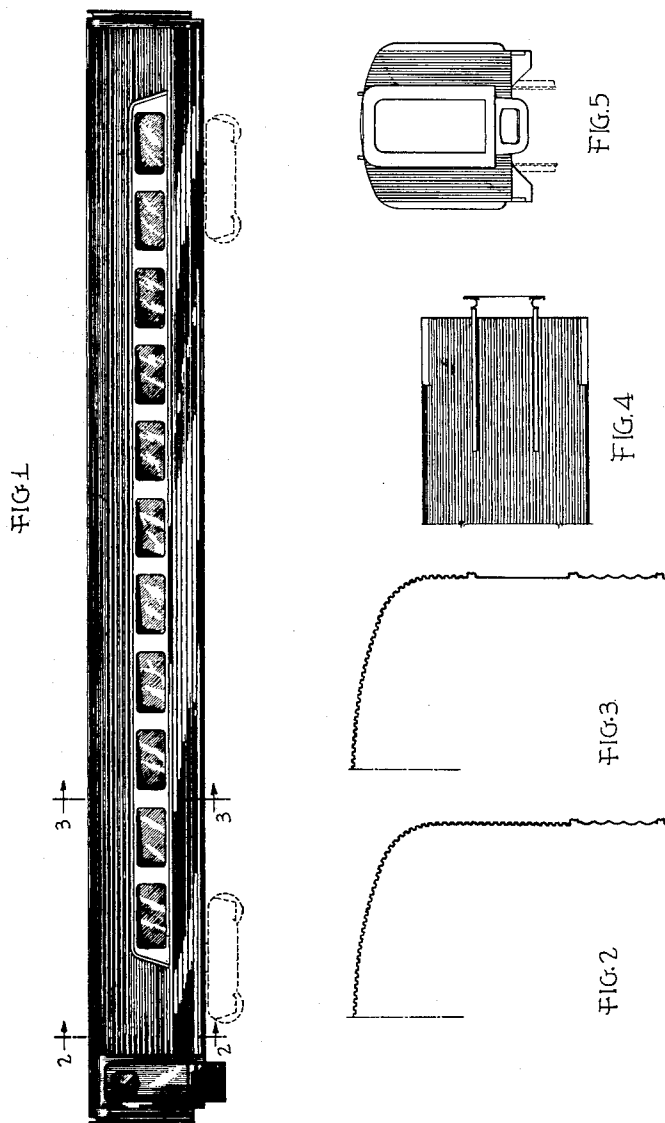


Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a railway passenger car embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a section of the skin on the line 2—2 of Fig. 1;

Fig. 3 is a section of the skin on the line 3—3 of Fig. 1;

Fig. 4 is a partial top plan view at one end of the car; and

Fig. 5 is an end elevation.

The essential features of my design reside in those portions shown in full lines in the drawing.
