Going south, turn right on
S.W. Anderson to 16th S.W. Here is
where Gus Papich (wife Eva) has
their store for many years. Before
Gus called it "Modern Grocery".
The first house next to the store
looks like a small business -
Sign says "Duncan". Vitalech
family once lived there. Right
next to that is where Katie
Stice lived (her first husband
? Marvin, died) - she remarried and
I don't know that name. There is
a small warehouse next (almost next)
to her and then our family
house. Has been painted and
worked on and apparently put
up for rent. Immediately next
to our house is now a large
warehouse, brand new. Stice see
some of the houses in back of ours
on 17th. In fact Clara (I don't know
her married name - was Zurek) is
still there. She and Katie don't want
to leave Riverside & Henderson.

Can't go through on 16th, so
went back short distance to W. Marginal

and small cleaning operation,
across from the gas station on N. Mayers

On 16th, left a few feet in
Raynolds housing - houses in
2 small houses where Protheron
lived for many years. He was the
"round turner".

Almost forgot to mention that
when I lived at Riverside,
immediately in front of our house
was a sand lot - kids loved
it, especially the boys for football,
baseball, etc. All the kids
swam in the Duwamish River
however, that was off limits
for me.

I heard my parents say that the
river ran in front of their house,
apparently when my dad built it.
Now again, everything down in
Riverside has changed since I left
- March in 1945. Old houses turned
into shops and small businesses, etc.

I continued down N. Marginal.
Believe the old brickyard was
close to S.W. Idaker, about the
4200 block, right off N. Marginal.
The kids thought it was pretty
spooky.

Continued up N. Marginal - seems
like much activity around here.
Came to S.W. Alcker and saw the
Metal Bldg, 4701 little south of
S.W. Alcker - "S.S. Yankee Clipper". It is
surrounded by a very nice little
park. Dinnel's store (Henry Dinnel)
must have been very close by.
I don't remember that the river
was so close.
