Up on 1st Ave for 6 months then back to dock in 1938. 1959 moved to south end of Coleman Dock. Paul Thiry (chief architect for World's Fair) designed the lights & advised them to paint ceiling gold. At that location from 1959 to 1963. Then moved to Paul Thiry designed long house on Pier 51 until 1988. Then moved to Pier 55.

Shrunken heads from J'ivaro Indians in Ecuador. Purchased from George Hayes in 1940's. Also torso of female. Female head broken off when ~~received~~ received. Repaired with plaster.
