

interview of Janet Skadan - battle born boppo (2004)

Janet Skadan - interview (June 22, 2000)

- granddaughter of Ferdinand Schmitz
- grew up on the Schmitz Estate
 - grandfather bought Cherry tree from Japan for his garden
- Mother Emmy Hartman - daughter of Ferdinand Schmitz
 - lived on an estate belonging to Ferdinand Schmitz
 - ↳ under lived on the other side
 - ↳ grandparents also lived there
- talks about the woods behind her house
 - grew up during the Depression
 - ↳ born in 1913 → Janet Skadan
- after her grandfather died, the garden was cared by a Japanese gardener Yoshio and his wife Shagino
 - ↳ during WWII they were interned at Tule Lake
 - ↳ after WWII they came back to work for Janet Skadan's Uncle Ferdinand Schmitz intent for creating Schmitz Park and leaving it to the city: small reminder of what the community looked like before

it was logged and settled. Also it was to remain natural; only the use of native plants.

Grandfather came from Germany
↳ started The Butler Hotel
(2nd and James)

↳ sent for his wife-to-be

↳ after she came his hotel burned down

↳ he rebuilt the Hotel in Pioneer Square

Janet went to Alki Elementary, Madison Junior High and West Seattle High School
