This is an agreement between Virgil Millett and Frederick A. Simeone with reference to trade for Mr. Millett's Ferrari Automobile, Serial Number 0710. Frederick A. Simeone will take possession of the above mentioned car in an as is, where is condition.

In exchange Mr. Millett will receive the following:

- 1) 1930 Bentley Speed 6 Automobile, Vanden Plas style body, with long fenders, Serial Number
- 2) 1930 Bentley Speed 6 Vanden Plas style LeMans body, Serial Number
- 3) 1926 Kissel 8-75 Speedster, Serial Number
- 4) 1931 Bentley 4½ Liter Supercharged LeMans car, Serial Number MS3942, currently owned two-thirds by Frederick Simeone and one-third by Virgil Millett.

The first car mentioned above will have a new top made for it, new tires, and whatever repair is necessary to make it mechanically excellent. It will be detailed according to previous agreement between Dr. Simeone and Mr. Millett.

The second car listed above will have new fenders made according to a style selected by Mr. Millett. In addition, the car will be detailed with all the mechanical components in excellent running condition, as previously agreed upon, between Frederick Simeone and Virgil Millett.

The 1926 Kissel Automobile will be put in proper running condition, be totally reupholstered, and have a new top made for it. It will be in clean, presentable condition. All exterior bright work will be re-nickeled.

The fourth car will have any necessary mechanical work performed promptly at Frederick Simeone's expense, and final detailing done at the expense of Virgil Millett. This car should be available promptly.

The exchange of cars takes place even though it is recognized that all cars will not be in Mr. Millett's possession because they require additional restoration. This letter, however, transfers full and complete ownership of these four cars to Mr. Millett. He has the title to the first three cars and the title to the fourth car is currently being transferred from England. A receipt of this title will be promptly sent to Mr. Millett who, by this document, is the owner of all four cars.
