- 1<sup>st</sup> That the next Annual Meeting should be held at the hired School House at two o'clock, P.M.
- 2<sup>d</sup> That on the next Annual Meeting it should be taken in Consideration to Designate a Site for a School House.
- 3<sup>d</sup> That a Tax of one Hundred and twenty Dollars should be raised for the building of a District School House.
- 4<sup>th</sup> That fifty Dollars should be raised for the repairing of a House, in which to be held Common School for the Space of three Months.
- 5<sup>th</sup> That a tax of Sixty Dollars should be raised for the Pay of Teachers Wages.
- 6<sup>th</sup> That a School should be taught by a Female Teacher for the Space of three Months, Commencing the first Day of July, 1858.

7th That five Dollars should be raised for Blank Books & Stationaries.




