

2 OVERCOME, 4 HURT IN FIRE

Two firemen were overcome by smoke and four others suffered minor injuries, Thursday night, when fire swept the store of Gale and Co., Wesleyville, with a loss of \$2,000.

C. Cummings and J. Schiefferle, both of Wesleyville, were overcome when volumes of smoke poured from the basement of the building. They were given first aid and Friday were said to be recovering. Four other firemen, the names of whom were not revealed, suffered minor cuts and bruises.

The blaze was discovered shortly after 8 p. m. when smoke poured from the basement. Firemen checked the flames as they broke through onto the first floor of the building. Much of the damage is confined to stocks stored in the basement of the building, according to W. C. Gray, chief of the Wesleyville fire department.
