

# Cow-Automobile Suit Thrown Out

The suit of Nelson Tefft against Patton Brothers, automobile dealers, was non-suited by Judge William E. Hirt in county civil courts Tuesday.

The suit was brought into civil court after Patton Brothers had sued Nelson Tefft following an automobile deal and the automobile concern had taken a cow, valued at \$150, in replevin action. Mrs. Tefft filed a property claim, alleging that the cow was her property and the issue was brought before the court.
