

## Jury to Decide Who Owns Cow

A jury of men and women, sitting in Judge Hirt's court, has been chosen to determine who owns a certain black and white cow, the value of which has been fixed at \$150.

The jury is hearing the case of Nelson I. Tefft against Patton Brothers, automobile dealers.

In outlining the case to the jury, Attorney Franklin B. Hosbach, counsel for the plaintiff, said that the plaintiff purchased an automobile from the defendant on a lease. In an effort to collect amounts due, the defendant is said to have replevined a cow, which was supposed to have been owned by the plaintiff. A claim was filed, showing that it was the property of Mrs. Tefft, wife of the defendant, who did not figure in the automobile transaction.
