The Sterling service station, a short distance west of the subway at Harborcreek was robbed of \$36 at 10:25 this morning by three bandits who stuck up Clyde Nonomaque, who was alone in the office.

Two men entered and covered Nonomaque with revolvers, saying, "If you don't put 'em up we'll shoot you full of holes." While one kept his gun pointed at the clerk the other went to the cash register. Unable to open it he signalled for a third man sitting in a machine in front of the station. He entered and succeeded in rifling the till, which contained \$36.

The trio then backed out of the office and jumped into a mud-splattered machine and headed toward Erie. Nonomaque immediately notified Wesleyville and Erie police. He said they were driving a Hupmobile touring car with a yellow top. He did not get the license number.

Nonomaque reported that the bandits were apparently between 25 and 30 years of age. One wore a kahki coat, while the others were dressed in dark clothes.
