**Scope and content:** This collection includes correspondence, photographs, video tapes, notebooks, photo albums, newspaper clippings, manuscripts, magazines, artwork, and other miscellaneous materials primarily created by descendants of the Boynton-Treadwell family. The objects vary in shape and size, from small photographs, to letters and program flyers, to many oversized photographs and artworks. Dates of objects primarily range from late 1800s through early 2000s. This collection offers insight into the day-to-day life, creative visions, and performance histories of the Treadwell-Boynton-Quitizow-Braun family and colleagues that created the Temple of [the] Wings' dance legacy.

**Arrangement:** This collection is arranged into five series based on the format/medium of the materials. Series A: Correspondence, Series B: Notebooks, Series C: Photos (subdivided into Albums, Sleeved/Folders, Oversized), Series D: Paper Materials, and Series E: Video Tapes.

**Historical context:** Temple of Wings is located at 2800 Buena Vista Way in Berkeley, California. It is a historic building known for its Greco-Roman style architecture designed and constructed by architect Bernard Maybeck in 1911. It was partially burned in the 1923 Berkeley fire and was subsequently rebuilt.

**Series**

**Series A:** Correspondence

**Extent:** 9.0 boxes

**Description:** Correspondence offers insight into the relationships between family members and their life updates over many decades.

**Arrangement:** Correspondence folders are primarily arranged alphabetically by the last name of the author of the letter, subdivided and sorted alphabetically by last name of the letter recipient, and further subdivided and sorted by date. Includes both type-written letters and hand-written letters. If no date is listed on the letter itself nor on the attached envelope or other materials, then the exact date or year of that item is unknown/unconfirmed. The year in the date column in the finding aid means that at least one item is from that year/date. If no date is written, the date or year is unknown/unconfirmed.

**Series B: Notebooks****Extent:** 9.0 boxes**Description:** The majority of notebooks were created by May Sulgwynn Boynton Quitzow, documenting choreography and dance class records.**Arrangement:** Boxes 1-4 are not arranged in a consistent manner. Box 5 contains Sulgwynn Quitzow's class rosters. Box 6 contains Oloel Quitzow-Braun's notebooks, presumably. Boxes 7-9 contain Sulgwynn Quitzow's choreography notebooks, arranged by year. Some notebooks may cross over multiple years. Please handle materials with care as there are very fragile notebooks included in this series.**Series C: Photos****Extent:** 19.0 boxes; 3.0 cartons**Subseries:** Albums; Folders; Oversized Boxes**Description:** The majority of photographs document festival performances over the 1900s. There are also portraits and group photos of the Treadwell-Boynton family members and extended family and descendants. Additionally, there are some photos documenting the architecture of the Temple of [the] Wings, including the temple before the 1923 fire.**Arrangement:** Photos are arranged into subseries pertaining to their format. Photos (Albums) are not arranged in a consistent method. Photos (Folders) are not arranged in a consistent method since additional photos continued to be discovered after initial arrangement. Photos (Oversized) are primarily arranged by photographer and year. Please look at the back of individual items for specific years where possible – some boxes and folders include dated and undated items. The year in the date column in the finding aid means that at least one item is from that year/date. If no date is written, the date or year is unknown/unconfirmed. Photos were kept together in boxes and folders in their original batches/groupings whenever possible.**Series D: Paper Materials****Extent:** 11.0 boxes**Description:** Paper materials include newspaper clippings, magazines, flyers, programs, bills/receipts, artworks, manuscripts, interviews, and miscellaneous lists and notes. Much of the newspaper clippings and magazines mention or refer to Temple of Wings, family members of the Treadwell-Boynton family, or extended family members. The manuscript written by Florence Treadwell Boynton reveals her thoughts and feelings about the famous dancer, Isadora Duncan. The flyers and programs document the various choreographies, themes, and musical sets for the Temple of Wings performances through the 20th century.**Arrangement:**

Boxes 1-3 primarily consist of miscellaneous writings, flyers, programs, interview transcripts, and bills/receipts. Boxes 4-5 consist of newspaper and magazine folders, organized by decade. Boxes 6-7 consist of Sulgwynn Quitzow's artwork. Box 8 contains Sulgwynn Quitzow obituaries. Boxes 9-11 dedicated to Florence Treadwell Boynton's manuscript about Isadora Duncan, roughly organized by chapter. The chapter numbers and titles in the finding aid are not final or authoritative, as some of the chapter numbers and chapter titles were revised across draft versions. Folder names include abbreviated titles for the chapters. Each folder holds multiple drafts of the same or similar chapter content.

**Series E: Video Tapes****Extent:** 2.0 boxes**Description:** Video tapes primarily consist of VHS tapes of Temple of Wings dance performances from the late

1960s through the early 2000s.

**Arrangement:** Video Tapes are not arranged in a consistent manner. There is a hard drive included that contains digitized versions of a selection of tapes. The finding aid includes a note for each tape that has been digitized.
