"We are in the belly of the beast, and this is quite a beast. It's very worrisome." Barbara Lubin, Director of Middle East Children's Alliance

Barbara Lubin is a woman who has been fighting the beast in its many manifestations for a long time. She is the mother of four children, including a 21 year old son with Downs Syndrome. For 21 years she has been suing school districts, fighting for free appropriate education for disabled children and acting generally as a children's advocate. She served on The Berkeley School board for four years. She has been in and out of El Salvador and has been involved with Nicaragua and The Anti-Apartheid Movement. We talked with Ms. Lubin on April 5th in The Berkeley Office of The Middle East Children's Alliance to learn more about her current work. This is some of what she had to say.
