Extremely rare and regal E.L. POWER Pendleton, Oregon c1912 white shotgun style Angora wooly chaps in fabulous condition. Power was a premier maker prior to Hamley Company moving to Pendleton. Marked POWER MAKER PENDLETON, ORE on the billet with the letters WB on the left billet that is original to the chaps when made. These chaps were given by important early old west collector James Walter Smith (1860-1932) to Woodward Bird House, a cowboy and World War fighter pilot who went on to discover the largest Uranium mine in the US. Two pockets and they measure 39" long to the bottom of the hair and 13" wide. This is just an amazing pair that we purchased at the Bryan Lebel Old West Auction in Cody, Wyoming in 1998.
