

SPURS 60 VISALIA STOCK SADDLE CO. CABBAGE PATTERN STYLE #9 SPURS C1910 WITH ORIGINAL STERLING DOME CONCHO STRAPS \$7,100

We purchased this fine pair of VISALIA STOCK CO. spurs from BILL WELCH at Cody, Wyoming in 2000. He bought them in the High Noon auction but then wanted to put his money into something else. When you hold these spurs in your hands, you can feel the rich history that is the brand as the craftsmanship has long held to be among the best to emerge from the California elaborate creations. These all original spurs have the detailed Cabbage pattern, or referred to by some as Northern California Paisley Pattern, on one side and steel chased design on the other. The spurs measure 6 7/8" long, 3 5/16" across inside the heel bands, and the heel bands measure 1 5/16" across the silver inlaid side. The 14 point rowels measure 1 3/4" across and are covered by engraved silver washers. The floral carved and spot bordered dove wing one piece straps have 2 1/4" sterling silver domed conchos with WMC engraved on a floral pattern. The straps and chains appear to be original to the spurs.
