

SPURS 22 C/1900 HUGE ORIGINAL SONORAN MEXICAN SPURS DOUBLE MOUNTED WITH STRAPS \$1,300

We purchased these at the 1998 Brian Lebel Old West Auction in Cody, Wyoming. Double mounted with significant silver inlays, original chains and huge $3\frac{7}{8}$ " rowels with jingle bobs, the spurs are all original and in fabulous condition. These are the real deal and have large stamped and carved leather straps which are likely original to the spurs. The spurs measure $8\frac{3}{4}$ " long, the heel bands measure $3\frac{3}{8}$ " across inside and are $5\frac{5}{8}$ " wide. The rowels measure $3\frac{7}{8}$ " across. This is a substantial pair of spurs and are quite heavy.
